NCJRS ON CD-ROM

Important news from the USA. The National Criminal Justice Research Service's NCJRS Database is now available on CD-ROM. NCJRS is well known as a major criminal justice reference database that has been available online in Australia and New Zealand for many years through the Dialog system. The full version of the Database has now been published on CD-ROM by Optical Publishing, Inc. The first version of the disc. released in June, contains more than 106,000 records, all with abstracts.

Each citation in the Database is divided into fields and users can search on any or all of these fields. The user can enter words, names, numbers, and/or dates in the search input screen. Many fields allow the following:

- Wildcat searches
- Range searches
- Boolean operators
- Proximity searches.

The Australian Institute of Criminology is currently negotiating with Optical Publishing, Inc to be agent/distributor for Australia and New Zealand for the NCJRS CD-ROM. We anticipate that the Australian subscription price will be A\$2,495/year. The CD-ROM will be updated every 6 months. Subscribers will receive the first disc, one additional disc that will completely update the first disc, a user manual, and a systems diskette for loading the CD-ROM.

Staff at the Institute, including both researchers and librarians, are already using the NCJRS CD-ROM. Anyone in Canberra, either visiting for the Special and Law Librarians Conference or otherwise, is encouraged to trial the CD-ROM at the J.V. Barry Library. Inquiries are welcome. AUSTROM

A new version of AUSTROM, Australian Social Science, Law and Education Databases on CD-ROM, is now available. This disc, designated Vol. 2, No. 1, is the fourth to be released.

This CD-ROM contains 13 Australian databases with one important new addition: AGIS, Attorney-General's Information Service, which is Australia's leading legal reference database. AGIS is produced by the Current Awareness Unit of the Lionel Murphy Library, Attorney-General's Department, Canberra. AGIS comprehensively indexes and abstracts articles from over 60 Australian, New Zealand and Pacific law journals, and selectively indexes and abstracts articles from major law journals from the United States, Canada, and the United Kingdom. It currently contains more than 40,000 records dating back to 1975. Other databases on AUSTROM include CINCH, APAIS, Australian Family and Society Abstracts, and Australian Education Index.
